Main Program:

Stephanie Dodd, elected State Board of Education member for our area (9th District) presented the new Ohio strategic education plan titled "Each Child, Our Future". The plan's Vision states: "In Ohio, each child is challenged to discover and learn, prepared to pursue a fulfilling post-high school path and empowered to become a resilient, lifelong learner who contributes to society". The plan has one (1) Goal: Ohio will increase annually the percentage of its high school graduates, who one year after graduation are enrolled in post-secondary education, or serving in the military, or earning a living wage, or engaged in a meaningful, self-sustaining vocation."



She further explained that the plan addresses three (3) core principles of equity, partnerships and school quality. Following four (4) learning domains of 1) Foundational Knowledge and Skills, 2) Well-Rounded Content, 3) Leadership and Reasoning, and 4) Social-Emotional Learning, the plan outlines 10 Priority Strategies to achieve the Plan Goal.
